



GARDENING BY THE MOON THOSE PESKY TURF WEEDS ARE STILL CAUSING PROBLEMS!

Have you noticed that the weeds growing in your yard are still a problem?

The reason is that Hurricane Harvey last year floated weed seeds and left them behind in your yard. To control these weeds in your Bermuda grass lawn, you have to attack back in two ways. You can control them as they start to germinate by using a pre-emergent herbicide. Pre-emergent needs to be applied in mid-February for spring weeds, mid-May for summer weeds and mid-September for winter weeds. You can find products called Preen or Halts for all of these applications. When you apply any product, always read and follow label instructions for best results and proper handling. **Always apply at label rate. Absolutely do no over apply!**
