
HURRICANE HARVEY

Update: Aug 31, 2017

Clear Creek is down to elevation 53.42' which is almost 0.7' **BELOW** top of bank. Below are screenshots of Harris County and the Clear Creek watershed that shows the rainfall in inches produced by Harvey. These are staggering numbers. Average annual rainfall for the Houston area is around 50". Some areas received almost this much from just this storm. Let the recovery and healing begin!





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
